Just recently I got a message from Dr Lakner. I share this below – if it is possible, it would be fine, indeed.

As the concert on Wednesday was well under 45 minutes, and the yesterday concert was a good try to find out what works the best, he asks, whether it is possible to include two arias with piano accompaniment, while the choir stays on the stage, but could rest a little bit.

Please, check the programme attached – the additional two pieces are indicated with red. This is probably not a major change, as they perform ALL what was sent earlier, but they add two solos (of the two latecomers, by the way), both 2 minutes 50 seconds, and still within the scheduled 45 min. time.

Would it be possible?

Sorry it came so late, but this is when it became transparent: the group needs ***a little*** rest after and before the big, voice-consuming Kodály and Bartók pieces. When hearing them, you'll understand.
